The Need

As the population in the Hill Country grows at a rapid pace, so too does the need for high quality surgical care close to home. Currently, the two operating rooms at Baylor Scott & White Medical Center – Marble Falls are functioning at 90% capacity, causing increased delays in the ability to schedule timely critical procedures.

Our Response

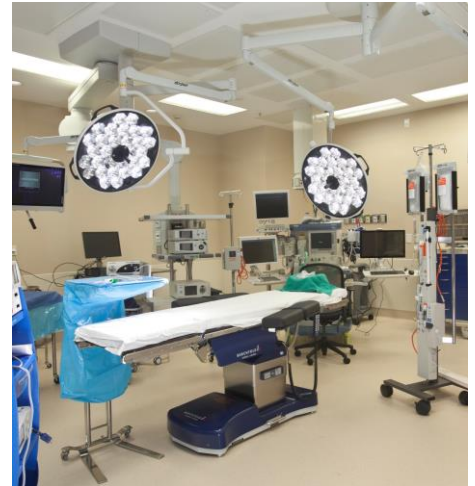
A third operating room will enable us to serve both existing and new patients as our community continues to grow. Some benefits include:

- Additional capacity, allowing us to serve the increased demand for surgical care due to growth in our community
- Reduced time patients must wait for scheduled surgeries
- Reduced turnover time for Total Joint Replacement procedures which require labor-intensive preparations

Philanthropic Opportunities

The third operating room will be built-out in a shell space already present at Baylor Scott & White Medical Center – Marble Falls. Advanced equipment is needed to outfit the operating room, such as:

 - Digital Capture Units
- Advanced Surgical Instruments
- Sports Medicine Surgical Instruments
- Bone and Joint Surgical Instruments
- Surgical Insufflator
- Neptune Suction Rover
- Orthopedics Tourniquet
- Orthopedics Helmet



With the addition of a 3rd operating room, availability for the following specialties will increase exponentially:

- Ophthalmology & Plastic Surgery
- Women's Health & Breast Surgery
- Total Joint Replacements
- General Surgery
